Siam Cement (SCC TB)

Seeing Gradual Improvements Ahead; Still BUY

BUY, new DCF-based THB299 TP from THB340, 19% upside with c.4% yield. Positive factors that were expected to boost Siam Cement's three major businesses have not materialised so far, especially as its petrochemicals segment faces a low season with no near-term catalysts.

However, we think SCC will be able to ride the uptrend once there is an

- We expect 1Q24 earnings to turn around from the 4Q23 loss to THB1.88bn (-89% YoY), as its packaging business sees a stronger YoY and QoQ performance, while the other two businesses remain impacted by market challenges. Excluding the THB12bn gain from the fair value adjustment of its investment in SCG Logistics recorded in 1Q23, 1Q24 core profit should decline 58% YoY.
- Cement and building materials division should perform better than the
 overall industry, which has been pressured by slower construction activities

 especially among low-rise property developers. Based on the increased
 high value-added (HVA) product proportion and more manageable
 production costs, we expect the division's net profit to grow QoQ.
- Petrochemicals business should improve QoQ on: i) Slightly higher spread of polypropylene (PP)-naphtha, and ii) the absence of expenses related to its Long Son Petrochemical project in Vietnam, which was halted for an unexpected turnaround. As the Rayong Olefins Cracker was still shut down during the quarter and resumed operations in March, polyolefin sales volumes fell slightly QoQ. Although both petrochemical spreads declined YoY in 1Q24, PP-naphtha rose 12% QoQ to USD326/ton while HDPE-naphtha fell 2% QoQ to USD354/ton. We also expect an inventory gain of THB500m in 1Q24 vs losses recorded in 1Q23 and 4Q23.
- Packaging segment should improve in 1Q24, as the packaging subsidiary's net profit is expected to grow 20% YoY and QoQ on: i) Higher sales volume, especially in the integrated packaging chain, ii) rising packaging prices amidst limited pulp supply, and iii) manageable production cost especially from recycled paper and sea freight. The business also saw higher demand for packaging from the F&B sector as tourism activities recovered strongly in 1Q24 in the region, including in Thailand and other ASEAN countries.
- We downgrade FY24 earnings mainly due to weak 1Q24 earnings prospects, as only SCC's packaging business seems to be promising. A major improvement in its petrochemicals business is needed in order to boost FY24 earnings. However, this is unlikely in 1Q24. We revise down FY24 net profit by 14% to THB28.5bn (+10% YoY).
- ESG. Our TP includes a 6% ESG premium based on SCC's ESG efforts over the past decade. Due to our earnings downgrade, our TP falls to THB299.



FY50 net zero carbon target.



Latest ESG-Related Developments

- Formulated action plans and budgets to achieve its net zero target by 2050, and aims to reduce its greenhouse gas emissions in Thailand and overseas operations by at least 20% by 2030 vs the base year of 2020 based on science-based targets.
- SCC aims to accelerate clean energy use, including solar and biomass, as well as implement an internal carbon pricing system to assess business risks and opportunities.
- SCC has set a target of increasing forest cover as a carbon sink of 3m rai by 2050.
